Helpful Reminders:

Sign-In/Out Sheets are required by State law. You must sign your child "in" and "out" of school. The In/Out sheets are located on a hook or baking rack outside child's your classroom door. Parents must sign with their legal first and last name. All names of people allowed to take your child from school

must be listed in your child's file. Notify the school of carpool arrangements with other families. If an adult is unfamiliar to us we will ask for a photo ID.

Please send your children to school in **shoes** that fit safely on their feet—no flip-flops. Try to avoid slip-ons or crocks. Boots, sandals



and high tops are OK, but tennis shoes/ sneakers with socks are the best. Our preference is Velcro!

Please keep water bottles inside lunchboxes and label all personal belongings.
